RYUKYU RESIDENT OFFICE (RRO)

The Ryukyu Resident Office, also known as RRO, was created in 1998, after combining the Tengan Resident Office and Urasoe Resident Office, to streamline Host Nation construction surveillance activities into one single office.

Located at Camp Lester, Okinawa, Japan, the office

oversees all Host Nation construction in Okinawa, providing comprehensive and professional engineering and construction surveillance services for all U.S. forces and installations. The Host Nation construction programs that this office supports are Japan Facilities Improvement Program (JFIP), Special Action Committee on Okinawa (SACO), Futenma Refurbishment Projects, and Defense



Policy Review Initiative/Alliance Transformation and Realignment Agreement (DPRI/ATARA), where Futenma Replacement Facilities (FRF) and Okinawa Consolidation (OkiCon) programs fall under.

Recent projects that were completed in JFY2019: JFIP AR1101, General Purpose Warehouse, Torii Station and OkiCon MC4001-T, MCCS Warehouse Facility, Camp Hansen. For ongoing projects, this office is presently working on numerous projects related to FRF program at Camp Schwab, which also includes several landfill projects for the airfield; OkiCon projects at Camp Kinser and Camp Hansen, in relation to the land return initiative affecting Camp Kinser, and military townhouse projects at Camp Foster and Kadena Air Base.



To accomplish it's primary mission, the office works closely with officials from the Okinawa Defense Bureau (ODB), as well as partners and customers from the Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps, DLA, DeCA, MCCS, AAFES and DoDEA.
