The Torii Resident Office is the youngest of the four Okinawa Area Resident Offices and was forged with the primary focus of executing the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) school projects. The team is comprised of seasoned Project Engineers and Construction Representatives capable of handling these large, highly visible projects.

While the Resident Office is based out of Camp Lester, Okinawa, Japan, there are currently project offices located on



Kadena Air Base and Camp Foster in support of new 21st Century Design Elementary Schools. Additionally, a new project office is being set up on Torii Station to execute multiple projects for the Special Operations Forces and other entities.



The Torii Resident Office focuses primarily on the execution of large 21st Century Design School Projects for DoDEA and has a growing portfolio of completed facilities including the newly constructed Zukeran Elementary School, fully renovated Kadena Middle School, and the largest DoDEA school facility, Kadena Elementary, at 194,000 square feet. Current construction includes the New Bob Hope Elementary and Killin Elementary Schools scheduled to be

complete for the 2021 school year. In addition to executing large DoDEA facilities, the office is branching into other areas with upcoming projects on Torii Station.

To accomplish it's primary mission, the office works closely with officials from DoDEA, as well as partners and customers from the Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps, DLA, DeCA, MCCS, AAFES to accomplish any task for the war-fighters, their mission, and their families.
