INTRODUCTION: The Yokota Resident Office is one of the seven Resident Offices in the Japan Engineer District. Our mission is to deliver high quality construction projects to our Air Force partners and their families.

LOCATION INFORMATION: The Yokota Resident Office is located on Yokota Air Base, which is positioned approximately 20 miles west from downtown Tokyo in the city of Fussa. The base is the headquarters of the 374th Airlift Wing which is currently used for airlift missions throughout East Asia. Yokota Air Base is also



home to U.S. Forces, Japan (USFJ) and the Fifth Air Force commands.

TYPE OF WORK PERFORMED: The Yokota Resident Office has contributed greatly to the Yokota Air Base's infrastructure. The resident office has been responsible for the delivery of numerous military construction and host nation projects for the Yokota Air Base partners and stakeholders. We recently completed the 21st Century designed Yokota High School, the C130J Flight Simulator and the renovation of the Commissary. The staff is currently managing the military housing renovation project on the north side of Yokota Air Base and the Air Force Special Operations Command (AFSOC) Airfield Apron and Site Infrastructure project. Under the host nation program, we recently delivered the Administrative Facility for the Security Forces and Defense Finance and Accounting Service. We are currently managing various infrastructure projects, including the new complex roadway at the Tokorowaza Transmitter Site.



STAKEHOLDERS: The Resident Office's primary stakeholders include all Squadrons of the 374th Airlift Wing, AFSOC, Air Force Civil Engineer Center (AFCEC), Department of Defense Education Activity (DODEA), North Kanto Defense Bureau, and the families living at Yokota Air Base. We also partner with members of different communities, including the Cities of Tokorozawa, Mizuho, and Kyotango.

Location Facts

- HOUSING Yokota Air Base has many housing locations, including North, West, and East Area Housing. Available units include 'tower' apartments, townhouse-style, and individual house units. Housing is assigned upon arrival and is rank/position based.
- SCHOOLS Yokota Air Base is home to the newly constructed 21st Century Yokota High School, Yokota Middle School, Yokota West Elementary School, and J.K. Mendel Elementary, which has a recently renovated Kindergarten and playground.
- MEDICAL & DENTAL SERVICES The 374th Medical Group provides a full-range of medical care needs, including dental services, family medicine, ENT, general surgery, mental health, optometry, pediatrics, physical therapy, orthopedics, OB/GYN, dermatology, and audiology, amongst others.
- DESCRIPTION OF LOCAL AREA The City of Fussa is large and diverse, and allows one to experience Japanese culture through a wide variety of Japanese restaurants and activities. There are also many nearby malls and grocery stores to shop at, including Seiyu, Aeon Mall, and LaLaport.
- TRANSPORTATION HUBS Yokota Air Base Passenger Terminal is available for Space A travel to many different locations, including Hawaii, South Korea, Singapore, Seattle, and Okinawa to name a few. Fussa Train Station is about a 5 10 minute walk from the base, and allows direct service to downtown Tokyo in about an hour.
- PETS Yokota Air Base has a fully staffed veterinarian service, which assists in annual pet vaccinations, routine pet care, and inspections/quarantine upon arrival to Japan.
- TELEVISION Armed Forces Network Tokyo is located on Yokota AB and provides radio services for your commute. Allied Telesis has established a shop on base for all of your internet and television needs.
- CELL PHONE Located in the BX, SoftBank provides members of the Yokota AB community the ability to quickly sign up for a cellular phone plan that can include talk, text, and data usage.
- EMPLOYMENT FOR SPOUSES & FAMILY MEMBERS Given the many amenities offered, Yokota AB is an excellent place for spouses to find work as well. This includes a huge array of positions to fit their needs from full-time to flex-hour positions, or they can choose to work teaching English to members of the surrounding Japanese community.
