The Zukeran Resident Office, also known as ZRO, is one of 4 resident offices within the Okinawa Area Office, part of the Japan District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Located at Camp Lester, Okinawa, Japan. The base is also referred to as Camp Kuwea. The new name was given in memory of Fred Faulkner Lester, one of the heroes who fought during the battle of Okinawa.

The office oversees construction on a variety of Military Construction (MILCON) and Sustainment, Repair, and Maintenance (SRM) type projects. Recently completed projects include the Temporary Lodging Facility at Camp Hansen and the P801
